THE SPIRIT OF CHRISTMAS

I imagine that there are many beautifully wrapped gifts like this one under your Christmas tree at home. Have you looked at the packages to see how many of them have your name on them? Have you tried to guess what might be in those packages? Do you ever sneak in when mam and dad aren't around and shake and squeeze the packages trying to figure out what might be inside? 
